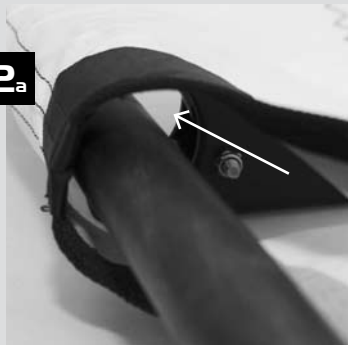
1. Insert the mast into the sleeve.

2. For a C2 sail, thread the mast through both cams.

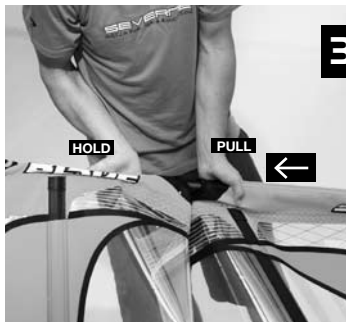

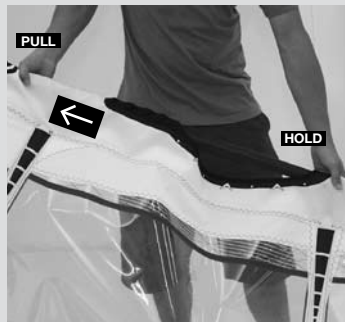
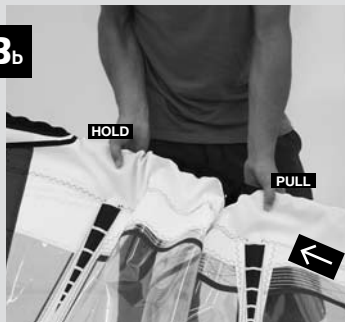
- 3a. Work the sail down the mast by pulling sections one at a time.

NOTE: Don't ram the mast into the sleeve without pulling the sail down bit by bit. The curve in the front of the sail will make the mast jam up against the front of the sleeve, this can damage the sail.

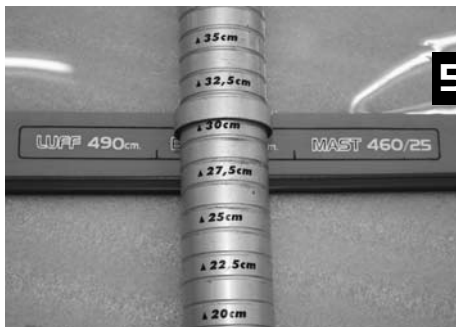
3b. On C2 sails, hold both cams and work the sail down the mast, pulling sections at a time.

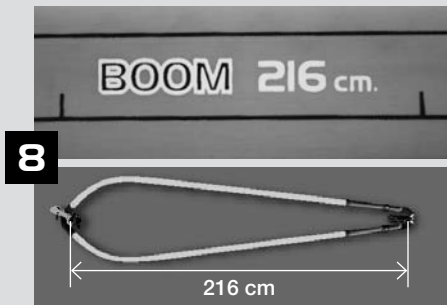
rigging guide : attach boom



7. Clamp the boom onto the mast.

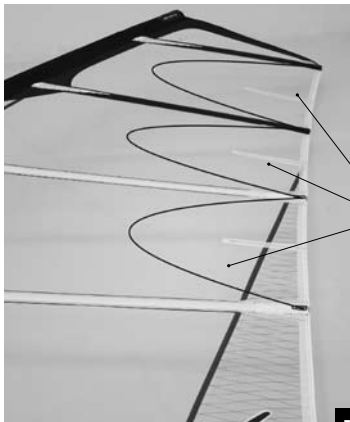


8. Set the boom to the recommended length as printed on the foot of the sail.

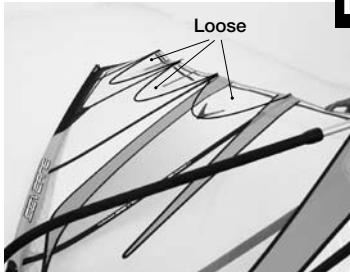
9. Outhaul the sail to the recommended setting.

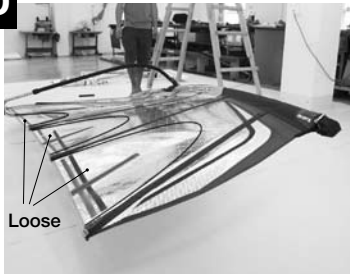
10. The correct amount of leech twist.
